Councilmember \_\_\_\_\_ introduced the following Ordinance in writing, which was read at the meeting:

**ORDINANCE 2019-10**

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF IRONDALE, ALABAMA FOR THE TERM BEGINNING NOVEMBER 2, 2020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRONDALE, ALABAMA, AT A REGULAR MEETING, DULY ASSEMBLED, A QUORUM BEING PRESENT, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** The salary of the Mayor shall be henceforth fixed at Twenty One Thousand and No/100 (\$21,000.00) Dollars per year, to be paid on a bi-weekly basis and/or pay period as all other city employees, with no allowance for expense reimbursement other than those expenses rightly chargeable to doing business for the City and provable by receipts. Further provided that the Mayor shall also be entitled to any and all benefits of any other Department Head of the City of Irondale, Alabama, plus family medical coverage. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect the ability of the Mayor to serve as head of any City Utility Board or other organization as permitted under the Code of Alabama, and to receive compensation therefrom as permitted by Alabama law.

**SECTION 2.** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama, which are inconsistent with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.

**SECTION 3.** That if any part, section or subdivision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to invalidate or impair the remainder of this Ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect, notwithstanding such holding.

**SECTION 4.** That the provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama and publication.
