MUNICIPAL COMPLEX IN MOTION

Our Irondale Municipal Complex Project will soon be going out for bid and entering the construction phase. The approximately 50,000 sq. ft. facility will house our City's administration, courts, police, water, dispatch, and inspections departments. Not only will we be modernizing our city facilities for citizens and employees, but we will also be vacating our existing spaces in the downtown core. This will pave the way for a redevelopment of that area with restaurants and entertainment. This facility will change the face of Crestwood Boulevard, and it is our hope that the city's investment will attract other new development to the Hwy. 78 corridor.
