 - 1. Resolution 2023-R-25-A amends Resolution 2023-R-25 authorizing the installation of one fire hydrant by The Water Works Board of the City of Birmingham on the east side of Bahenle Lane, approximately 200' east of the intersection of Bahenle Lane and Alton Road. (*McDaniel*)

2. Resolved, That Resolution 2024-R-141 authorizes the naming of the Large Dog Park at the Tails by the Rails Dog Park as “Dr. Weber’s Paw-some Place” in honor of the late Dr. William Weber. *(Mayor Stewart)*
3. Resolution 2024-R-142 authorizes Mayor James D. Stewart, Jr., or his designee, to execute a construction easement agreement with Tower Development, Inc. at the property located at 3521 Ratliff Road for a construction project at Kirkwood by the River. *(Mayor Stewart)*
