 - 1. Resolved, That Resolution 2024-R-86 allows the City of Irondale to participate in the 2024 “Back to School” Sales Tax Holiday beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, July 19, 2024, and ending at twelve midnight on Sunday, July 21, 2024. *(Mayor Stewart)*
 - 2. Resolved, That Resolution 2024-R-87 authorizes the payment of public funds to Freshwater Land Trust in the amount of \$10,500.00 with \$3,500.00 from the 2023-24 FY Discretionary Fund of Councilor Cindy Cuellar, \$3,500.00 from the 2023-24 FY Discretionary Fund of Councilor David Spivey, \$2,000.00 from the 2023-24 FY Discretionary Fund of Councilor Robert Box, \$1,000.00 from the 2023-24 FY
