 - 1. Resolved, That Resolution 2024-R-24-A amends Resolution 2024-R-24 that approves an alcohol license for Lucky Z Inc. d/b/a Wings R King located at 5429 Beacon Drive, Irondale, AL 35210. (*Mayor Stewart*)
 - 2. Resolved, That Resolution 2024-R-38 appoints the voting delegate and an alternate voting delegate of the City of Irondale, Alabama for the Alabama League of Municipalities Annual Business Meeting. (*Allison*)

3. Resolved, That Resolution 2024-R-39 authorizes the allocation of public funds in the amount of \$2,500 to Irondale Middle School from the 2023-24 FY Discretionary Fund of Mayor James D. Stewart, Jr. to be used exclusively for uniforms for the Irondale Middle School Band. (*Mayor Stewart*)
