XIV. Consent Agenda – *Councilor Box made a motion that the consent agenda be approved as amended. Councilor Sims seconded this motion. A vote was held and this motion passed unanimously.*

1. Resolved, That Resolution 2022-R-149 authorizes the City of Irondale to enter into an agreement with the Alabama Department of Transportation for the lease of an area of right of way East of Highway 78 to be used for a Canoe Launch for the City of Irondale. *(City)*
4. Resolved, That Resolution 2022-R-152 authorizes the donation of \$10,000.00 to the Shades Valley High School for use by the Shades Valley Football Team. *(City)*
5. Resolved, That Resolution 2022-R-153 authorizes the allocation of public funds in the amount of \$34,000.00 from the 2021-22 FY Discretionary Fund of Mayor James D. Stewart, Jr., the 2021-22 FY Discretionary Fund of Councilor John London, the 2021-22 FY Discretionary Fund of Councilor Robert Box, and the 2021-22 FY Discretionary Fund of Aaron Sims to be used exclusively for the 135th Anniversary Music Festival on September 25th, 2022, at Beacon Park. *(City, London, Sims, and Box)*

3. Resolved, That Resolution 2022-R-151 authorizes the City of Irondale to enter into an agreement with Charles Williams & Associates for architectural and engineering services for a Library facility in an amount not to exceed \$489,800.00. (City)

Councilor Sims made a motion that Resolution 2022-R-151 be approved. Councilor London seconded this motion. A roll call vote was held and this motion passed with Councilors Spivey, Sims, Box and London voting in favor of the motion, and Councilor Cuellar voting against the motion.

1. Ordained, That Ordinance 2022-15 rezones the property located at 4999 Overton Road, Irondale, Alabama 35210 from an R-2 Residential District to an I-1 Light Industrial District. (City)

(Ordinance 2022-15 was continued by the Council during the Public Hearing to determine if property owners within 500 feet of the requested rezoning property received notice of the Public Hearing. During the approval of the form of the agenda, the Council voted to continue Ordinance 2022-18.)

2. Ordained, That Ordinance 2022-16 rezones the property located at 2616 Floyd Bradford Road, Trussville (Irondale), AL 35210 from C-1 Commercial District to an A-1 Agriculture District. (City)

Councilor Sims made a motion that Ordinance 2022-16 be considered read. Councilor Cuellar seconded this motion. A roll call vote was held and this motion passed with all councilors voting in favor of the motion.

Councilor Sims made a motion that all rules that would prevent the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2022-16 be suspended. Councilor Cuellar seconded this motion. A vote was held and this motion passed with all councilors voting in favor of the motion.

Councilor Sims made a motion that Ordinance 2022-16 be adopted. Councilor Cuellar seconded this motion. A roll call vote was held and this motion passed with all councilors voting in favor of the motion.

3. Ordained, That Ordinance 2022-17 rezones the property located at 4283 Hillsedge Road, Irondale, AL 35210 from A-1 Agriculture District to an R-1 Residential District. (City)

Councilor Sims made a motion that Ordinance 2022-17 be considered read. Councilor London seconded this motion. A roll call vote was held and this motion failed with Councilors Cuellar and Box not voting in favor of the motion.

(Council President Spivey stated that Ordinance 2022-17 had been read, and that Ordinance 2022-17 could be presented for a second reading at a later date.)

4. Ordained, That Ordinance 2022-18 rezones the property located at proposed Lot 2B of the resurvey of Lots 2 and 3 of Porter Estates property located at 3129 Old Ivy Rd. Irondale, AL 35210 from A-1 Agriculture District to an E-1 Estate District. (City)

(Ordinance 2022-18 was continued during the Public Hearing to determine if deed restrictions exist to prohibit the subdividing of the lot. During the approval of the form of the agenda, the Council voted to continue Ordinance 2022-18.)

5. Ordained, That Ordinance 2022-19 modifies Chapter 18, Article I, Division 2, Sec. 18-14 of the *Municipal Code of the City of Irondale, Alabama* related to minimum water usage and water rates. (City)

Councilor Sims made a motion that Ordinance 2022-19 be considered read. Councilor Box seconded this motion. A roll call vote was held and this motion passed with all councilors voting in favor of the motion.

Councilor Sims made a motion that all rules that would prevent the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2022-19 be suspended. Councilor Box seconded this motion. A vote was held and this motion passed with all councilors voting in favor of the motion.

Councilor Sims made a motion that Ordinance 2022-19 be adopted. Councilor Box seconded this motion. A roll call vote was held and this motion passed with all councilors voting in favor of the motion.

6. Ordained, That Ordinance 2022-20 modifies Chapter 7.5, Sec. 7.5-15 of the *Municipal Code of the City of Irondale, Alabama* related to the garbage fees. (City)

Councilor Sims made a motion that Ordinance 2022-20 be considered read. Councilor Box seconded this motion. A roll call vote was held and this motion passed with all councilors voting in favor of the motion.
