VI. Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that at its regular public meeting beginning at 6:00 p.m. on **Wednesday, January 6, 2021**, in the Irondale City Council Chambers located at 101 20th Street South, Irondale, Alabama 35210, within Jefferson County, Alabama (the “City Council Chambers”), the City Council of the City of Irondale (the “City”) will hear comments from interested citizens concerning the proposed rezoning of the property located at 4101 Buckthorn Road, Irondale, AL 35210 from an R-2 Residential District to a C-1 Commercial District. Councilmember Wilson moved the motion and it was seconded by Councilmember Box to open the public hearing.

Butch Jerrols stated that Planning and Zoning approved of the rezoning of This property and no one attended the Planning and Zoning Meeting in opposition of rezoning this property.

David Hall, owner of the property, stated virtually that he proposed building a 20’ x 50’ Butler Building on the property to relocate his Personal Training Company from Birmingham to Irondale.

Jackie Crandall, 4301 Cahaba Cove Road, Irondale Al. 35210, spoke in favor of the rezoning of this property.

Councilmember Wilson moved the motion to leave the public hearing And it was seconded by Councilmember Cuellar.

New Business

1. Resolved, That Ordinance 2021-01 rezones the property located at 4101 Buckthorn Road, Irondale, Alabama 35210 from R-2 Residential District to a C-1 District.
