

Bearden introduced the following Resolution at the meeting:

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R-90

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama (the "City") previously solicited bids for building renovations at Well #2 ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, bids were received on December 10, 2019 and have been reviewed by the City staff; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has recommended to the City Council that the Project be awarded to Jeremy Enterprises, LLC in that it submitted the lowest responsive bid of \$129,817.01 and is a responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council at a regular meeting, duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:

1. That the foregoing recitals form an integral part of this Resolution and are incorporated herein as if copied herein in full.
2. That the City Council does, by the adoption of this Resolution, determine that Jeremy Enterprises, LLC submitted the lowest responsive bid for the Project in the amount of \$129,817.01 and is a responsible bidder.
3. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to award the bid to Jeremy Enterprises, LLC, pursuant to the determination set out in paragraph 2 above for the Project.
4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Irondale City Council.
