**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama (the “City”) desires to enter into a Master Contract for Lighting Services – Illumination (Governmental) with Alabama Power Company (“Contract”) in substantially the same form and substance of the contract attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference and marked Exhibit “A” for identification; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council at a regular meeting, duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:

1. That the foregoing recital forms an integral part of this Resolution and is incorporated herein as if copied herein in full.
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Contract with Alabama Power Company in on behalf of the City of Irondale, Alabama, in substantially the same form and substance of the contract attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference and marked Exhibit “A” for identification and any and all documents necessary to give this resolution full effect.
4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Irondale City Council.
