

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-R-22

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama (the “City”) desires to apply for a grant for Transportation Alternative Program (“TAP”) funds for the construction of sidewalks along 16th Street (from 2nd Ave. to 5th Ave), 20th Street (from 1st Ave. to 2nd Ave.), 2nd Avenue (from 16th Street to 20th Street), and 5th Avenue (from 16th Street to 17th Street all as shown on the map attached hereto marked as Exhibit “A” which is incorporated herein by reference as if copied herein in full (the “Project”); and,

WHEREAS, the cost estimate for the City’s twenty (20%) percent share of the Project cost is \$159,997.02. The cost estimate for the Federal government’s eighty (80%) percent share of the Project cost is \$639,988.07 is as shown on the attached Cost Estimate marked Exhibit “B” which is incorporated herein by reference as if copied herein in full.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council at a regular meeting, duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:


1. That the foregoing recitals form an integral part of this Resolution and are incorporated herein as if copied herein in full.
2. That the City Council does, by the adoption of this Resolution, authorize the submittal of an application for Transportation Alternative Program (“TAP”) funding for sidewalk construction along 16th Street (from 2nd Ave. to 5th Ave), 20th Street (from 1st Ave. to 2nd Ave.), 2nd Avenue (from 16th Street to 20th Street), and 5th Avenue (from 16th Street to 17th Street all as shown on the map attached hereto marked as Exhibit “A” (the “Project”) in accordance with the Cost Estimate attached hereto marked as Exhibit “B”;
3. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effect the authorization in paragraph 2.
4. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Irondale City Council.
