**A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT ELECTIONS MANAGER
AND AFFIRM STATUTORY ABSENTEE ELECTION MANAGER
FOR THE 2020 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**


WHEREAS, municipal elections to elect a mayor and five city council members are held quadrennially by statute in the City of Irondale; and

WHEREAS, a municipal election will be held on Tuesday, August 25, 2020, and a run-off election, if necessary, will be held on Tuesday, October 6, 2020, in compliance with Alabama law; and

WHEREAS, in the event, the mayor or other chief executive officer of any city or town is a candidate in any municipal election held under the provisions of this article, he shall be disqualified to perform the duties set forth in Section 11-46-36 and said duties shall be performed by a disinterested person appointed by the board of aldermen or other governing body of the city or town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama that Josh McDaniel, Fire Chief shall be and is appointed as the municipal elections manager for the 2020 election cycle, along with the duties of absentee elections manager as set out in the Code of Alabama.


