SERVICE AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into by and between the City of Irondale, Alabama, a municipal corporation, and We are 1, an Alabama non-profit corporation.

WHEREAS, Contractor desires to perform recreational sporting services for the youth of the City of Irondale; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of obtaining their services as designated below.

THEREFORE, the parties hereto promise, covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Contractor hereby agrees to provide recreational sporting services to the youth within the City.
2. In consideration of the services to be performed by Contractor, the City does hereby agree to pay to said Contractor the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred and NO/100 Dollars and 00/100 (\$2,500.00).
3. Contractor shall provide to the City as soon after the end of the preceding fiscal year as practicable an audit report and any other reports and information deemed appropriate by the City Clerk/Treasurer of the City.
4. Absent any determination of intentional default, this agreement shall renew annually upon the approval of the then current fiscal year budget by the City Council under the same terms and conditions unless (1) canceled on sixty (60) days written notice by either party; or, (2) funds are not appropriated to the Contractor by the Irondale City Council in such budget.
