

Resolution 2022-R-128

A resolution authorizing the City of Irondale to accept a grant from the Alabama Department of Environmental Management

WHEREAS, the City of Irondale, Alabama submitted a grant application to the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM) to receive a grant from the Alabama Recycling Fund to better provide recycling services for its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Irondale, Alabama will receive a maximum amount of \$311,777.000 from ADEM through the Alabama Recycling Fund for the purchase of a curbside collection vehicle in the approximate amount of \$196,777.00 and 64 gallon curbside carts in the approximate amount of \$115,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Irondale, Alabama provides recycling to its residents for free while struggling with contamination from using recycling bins with no lids; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Irondale believes it is important that the City expand its recycling program and cut down on contamination in its recycling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby accepts the Alabama Recycling Fund Grant from the Alabama Department of Environmental Management for the purchase of a curbside collection vehicle and 64 gallon curbside carts and approves the execution of the Alabama Recycling Fund Grant Agreement (in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A) and any and all documents necessary to obtain such grant by Mayor James D. Stewart, Jr. or his designee.
