

Resolution 2022-R-129

A Resolution Declaring that Certain Fire Department Personal Property is not needed for Public or Municipal Purposes and Directing the Disposal

WHEREAS, the City of Irondale, Alabama, is the owner of certain unneeded surplus personal property, namely forty-nine (49) sections of 5” Fire Hose; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it would be in the best public interest to dispose of said personal property by donation to a local fire department for use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRONDALE, ALABAMA, that Mayor James D. Stewart, Jr. or his designee is hereby authorized to dispose of forty-nine (49) sections of 5” fire hose used by the Irondale Fire Department through the donation of twenty-four (24) sections to the Mulga Fire Department and twenty-five (25) sections to the Holly Pond Fire Department.
