A Resolution Declaring that Certain Personal Property is not needed for Public or Municipal Purposes and Directing the Disposal by Trade-in to Warrior Tractor and Equipment

Stewart, Jr. or his designee is hereby authorized to dispose of a 2011 John Deere 85D excavator through trade-in to Warrior Tractor and Equipment as part of a purchase of a new excavator by the City and to execute any documents necessary to effectuate such trade-in.
