

Resolution 2022-R-140

A Resolution Declaring that Certain Personal Property is not needed for Public or Municipal Purposes and Directing its Disposal by Sale

WHEREAS, the City of Irondale, Alabama, is the owner of certain unneeded surplus personal property, namely a 2016 Pierce 100' Ladder Truck previously utilized by the Irondale Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it would be in the best public interest to dispose of said personal property by sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRONDALE, ALABAMA, that Mayor James D. Stewart, Jr. or his designee is hereby authorized to dispose of a 2016 Pierce 100' Ladder Truck through the sale of such property to the Mississippi State Fire College for the sum of \$850,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Mayor Stewart or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to accomplish such sale.
