

Resolution 2022-R-160

Resolution Authorizing Execution of Voluntary Disclosure Agreements

WHEREAS, certain taxpayers will, from time to time, desire to disclose certain taxes they wish to remit to the City of Irondale;

WHEREAS, the taxpayers in question will not have obtained a business privilege license from the City of Irondale, although such license may or may not be required;

WHEREAS, the taxpayers in question and the taxes they wish to disclose to the City would not ordinarily be known to the City because of the nature of the taxpayers' business activities within Irondale; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Irondale that these taxes be collected and that the taxpayers obtain a business privilege license from the City of Irondale.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Irondale, in regular meeting duly assembled, a quorum being present, that the Mayor is authorized and hereby directed to enter into Voluntary Disclosure Agreements with business taxpayers in those cases where appropriate and as permitted by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor may enter into such agreements on behalf of the City, and that the Mayor is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations concerning such agreements.
