

Resolution 2022-R-215

Authorizing the execution of a service agreement with the Irondale Community Foundation

WHEREAS, there are citizens in the City of Irondale, Alabama (“City”) who are insecure in the most basic needs of life, such as food and clothing; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that a public purpose is served through the obtaining of the services of the Irondale Community Foundation., an Alabama non-profit corporation, to help feed those in the City who are food insecure during this time.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama, in regular meeting duly assembled, a quorum being present, that Mayor James D. Stewart, Jr. is hereby authorized to execute a Service Agreement with the Irondale Community Foundation in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

EXHIBIT A

SERVICE AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into by and between the City of Irondale, Alabama, a municipal corporation, and the **Irondale Community Foundation**, an Alabama non-profit corporation.

WHEREAS, the Irondale Community Foundation performs certain services for the citizens of the City of Irondale; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of obtaining their services as designated below.

THEREFORE, the parties hereto promise, covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Irondale Community Foundation hereby agrees to provide services to those within the City who are insecure for basic needs. Such services shall include, but not be limited to, the provision of food.
2. In consideration of the services to be performed by the Irondale Community Foundation, the City does hereby agree to pay to said Irondale Community Foundation an amount not to exceed Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$3,500.00).
3. The Irondale Community Foundation shall provide to the City as soon after the end of the preceding fiscal year as practicable an audit report and any other reports and information deemed appropriate by the City Clerk/Treasurer of the City.
4. Absent any determination of intentional default, this agreement shall renew annually under the same terms and conditions unless (1) canceled on sixty (60) days written notice by either party; or, (2) funds are not appropriated by the Irondale City Council.
