

**Resolution 2022-R-31**

***Authorizes City Detect, Inc. to perform a demonstration of services for the City of Irondale through temporary attachment of technology to City garbage trucks***

**WHEREAS**, it is an objective of the City of Irondale (“City”) to combat blight and property code violations; and

**WHEREAS**, through the use of technology, City Detect, Inc. offers a highly technical identification and reporting service which automatically detects blight and property code violations using artificial intelligence and machine learning; and

**WHEREAS**, City Detect Inc. has requested that the City allow it to perform a demonstration of its product capabilities at no expense to the City so that the City may evaluate City Detect Inc.’s services for use.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama, in regular meeting duly assembled, a quorum being present that City Detect, Inc. is hereby authorized to perform a demonstration of services for the City of Irondale, Alabama through the temporary attachment of technology to the City’s garbage trucks.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that City Detect Inc. shall have access to such City data pertaining to the parcels within the City as necessary to provide an effective demonstration of its property code violation and blight detection services. Such information shall include, but not be limited to, GIS data, shape files, plat data, and telemetry information.
