

Resolution 2023-R-136-A

*Authorizing the execution of a Service Agreement with
Central Alabama Junior Roller Derby d/b/a Steel City Slayers
for Youth Roller Derby in the City of Irondale*

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama, in regular meeting duly assembled, a quorum being present, that Mayor James D. Stewart, Jr., or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a Service Agreement with Central Alabama Junior Roller Derby d/b/a Steel City Slayers (in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A) for the provision of recreational sporting services to the youth in the City of Irondale, specifically utilizing the Irondale Civic Center for a maximum of four (4) six-hour time slots for practices and/or games of a youth roller derby league.

EXHIBIT A

SERVICE AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into by and between the City of Irondale, Alabama, a municipal corporation, and Central Alabama Junior Roller Derby d/b/a Steel City Slayers, a domestic non-profit corporation (“Contractor”).

WHEREAS, Contractor desires to perform certain community recreational sporting services for the youth of the City of Irondale, specifically youth roller derby; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of obtaining Contractor’s services as designated below.

THEREFORE, the parties hereto promise, covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Contractor hereby agrees to provide recreational sporting services to youth within the City. Such services shall include the provision of up to four (4) six-hour blocks of practices and/or games held at the Irondale Civic Center for youth roller derby over the course of a year.
2. In consideration of the services to be performed by Contractor, the City does hereby allow Contractor to use the Irondale Civic Center without charge. Dates of use of the Irondale Civic Center are to be determined at a later date scheduled at the discretion of the Manager of the Irondale Civic Center, Brad Doss.
3. The term of this Agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year beginning on the date of the last party to execute this Agreement.
