WHEREAS, the City of Irondale publicly opened and read aloud the Project bids that were submitted, as shown in the table below:



WHEREAS, Empire Pipe & Supply Company, Inc. and Southern Pipe & Supply Company, Inc. were not responsive bidders as both companies bid on the alternate item and did not bid on the main item.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Irondale, Alabama, in regular meeting duly assembled, a quorum being present as follows:

1. The bid submitted by Ferguson Waterworks for the restrained joint pipe in the total amount of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Two and 00/100 Dollars (\$120,992.00) is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bidder.
2. Mayor James D. Stewart, Jr., or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any necessary documents with Ferguson Waterworks for such amount not to exceed \$120,992.00 to effectuate this bid acceptance.



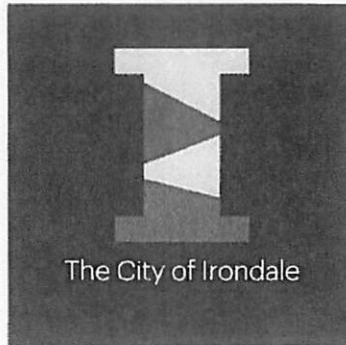
