Authorizes the execution of a Service Agreement with Cahaba River Coalition





AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the **City of Irondale, Alabama**, a municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), and the **Cahaba River Coalition**, an Alabama non-profit corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Cahaba River Coalition").

WHEREAS, the Cahaba River Coalition was established to restore and protect the Cahaba River Watershed and its rich diversity of wildlife;

WHEREAS, a portion of the Cahaba River is located within the city of Irondale and provides many recreational opportunities to the citizens of the city; and


WHEREAS, the City is desirous of obtaining Cahaba River Coalition's services as designated below for the protection of the Cahaba River and the recreational and community benefits that it offers.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the premises and the mutual promises of the parties hereinafter set forth, the parties agree as follows:

1. Cahaba River Coalition hereby agrees to provide protection and restoration services to the Cahaba River within the city of Irondale and to provide recreational opportunities and community benefits to the citizens of the City and to promote the health, safety and welfare of its citizens.
2. The City shall pay to Cahaba River Coalition a total of \$5,000.00. Payment will be made upon receipt of a copy of the Cahaba River Coalition's most recently completed financial statements and any other reports and information deemed appropriate and requested by the City.


