Film Birmingham Partnership Agreement

Film Birmingham and The City of Irondale, Alabama ("Irondale")

Irondale agrees that Film Birmingham is hereby designated as the primary point of contact for entities desiring to film in Jefferson County. All requests to film within Jefferson County will be made through Film Birmingham (filmbirmingham.org).

All entities interested in filming projects in Jefferson County should first register their project and agree to Film Birmingham's production guidelines. By registering, Film Birmingham knows who is filming in the area and will be better postured to assist under tight deadlines.

Production registration is available, free of cost, at filmbirmingham.org. Entities desiring to film within the city limits of Irondale shall be required to complete a Film Production Permit Application with Irondale. Registering with Film Birmingham would not replace this city permit requirement.

Irondale agrees to provide Film Birmingham with preferred City contacts and permitting procedures that are designated to specific municipal assets. Film Birmingham will link municipal specific information on the Film Birmingham website and keep municipalities informed of upcoming and ongoing production activities.

Film Birmingham can provide additional support and services, including, but not limited to:

- Metered parking reservations
- Municipal property rentals
- County wide permitting (ex. right of way closures)
- Location scouting
- Insurance confirmation and collection
